### ***Class Rules***

- All grains and plants exhibited must have been grown in 2019 by exhibitor.

### ***Prizes***

- \* Sections 9 & 10: 1<sup>st</sup> - \$10.00; 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$3.00; 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$2.00 (prizes donated by **LINDA & ERIC MacLEOD**)

### ***Sections***

1. Spring wheat (in clean 1 quart of 1 litre jar)
2. Fall wheat (in clean 1 quart or 1 litre jar)
3. Barley (in clean 1 quart or 1 litre jar)
4. Oats (in clean 1 quart of 1 litre jar)
5. Field corn on cob (6 ears)
6. Haylage (one peck)
7. Established hay (12" section of small square bale or cut portion about the same size from a large bale)
8. Second cut hay (12" section of small square bale or cut portion about the same size from a large bale)
9. \* Tallest sweet corn (5 stalks)
10. \* Tallest sunflowers (3 stalks)
11. Prettiest sunflowers (2 heads)
12. Largest sunflower head (well-seeded)
