Class Rules

- 1. Please read general rules at the front of this Fair Book.
- 2. All articles to be new and made by the exhibitor.
- 3. Old, soiled or defaced work will not be judged.
- 4. Entries shown previously at the Chatsworth Fair are not eligible for prizes.
- 5. No straight pins please only safety pins.
- 6. All entry tags must show measurements where required.
- 7. Helpful hint: Homecraft articles are best stored in fabric rather than plastic.
- New exhibitors should note on hidden portion of tickets that you have not exhibited previously in Homecraft Class 14.
- 9. First prize only awarded in sections 9 and 55.
- 10. Prizes are as indicated, specials take preference to the section.

Hand Quilted and Machine Quilted Competitions

The following rules apply to **Sections 1-9** are based on the OAAS website at

- RULES: 1. Please review the General Competition Rules Document for 2024
- 2. The quilt must be solely made, and hand or machine quilted by the exhibitor and exhibited and judged at a local Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies (OAAS) fair to be eligible for this competition.
- 3. Quilts to be measured on the perimeter. Total perimeter measurement to be a minimum of 324 inches. Note the quilt can be square, rectangular etc. all 4 sides must be measured to determine the perimeter measurement. For example, a square quilt that is at least 81"x 81" or a rectangle quilt that is at least (90" x 72")
- 4. The quilting must be through all 3 layers (top, batting and back) and not be mounted on a frame. The quilt may have a sleeve attached to the back for the purpose of hanging the quilt.
- 5. The winning OAAS Hand or Machine Quilt will not be eligible to compete in any future OAAS fair, district and/or provincial competitions.
- 6. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to give credit to the original designer of the quilt pattern based on copyright rules.
- 7. **For Machine Quilted Quilts** The use of domestic, mid arm, and/or long arm equipment is permitted on hand or computer guided machine quilt entries.
